Recognized for her outgoing personality and high energy appeal, Meechie’s genuine personality and infectious spirit, on and off the air, has earned her respect from peers all over.

Meechie started her radio career with Al “The Voice” Beard as hosts of the infamous music program, “Gospel Music in Motion” via 106.3FM WYCA from 2000-2003. While co-hosting on Saturdays, she became a community volunteer on 89.3 WKKC (Kennedy King College) on Thursday nights and later, Sundays with Keno “KG” Greer on the contemporary gospel hit show, “Street Sermonz” which aired from 2003-2007 in its respective time slots.

Meechie received rave reviews from her colleagues for her tireless service and heartfelt support of everyone; hence, as a result, became the recipient of the Gospel Music Workshop of America’s “James Cleveland Horizon Award” in August 2003.

Meechie’s professionalism, poise and bubbly personality has provided endless opportunities for her to host concerts, fashion shows, youth programs, fund-raisers, school events, city sponsored functions and work related gatherings.

A few years ago, Meechie was Senior Producer of the hit internet radio show, “Pure Sound Gospel with Wanda Ewing and Kenny Lewis”.

In December 2014, she traveled to the country of Haiti on a missions trip with Jerusalem Baptist Ministry and her local church to offer hope through assistance in school rehabilitation, support and love. She has also served the Englewood Community by offering homemade chicken noodle soup, water and crackers accompanied by a hug to those in need as part of Church for Everyday People’s Community Connection.

Meechie currently serves on the Board of Directors of W.I.S.H.I.N.G. (Women Inspiring Success and Hope in Girls), a group focused on the personal and professional development of girls ages 8-14. She’s a member of the Chicago Area Gospel Announcers Guild, Ogden Park Advisory Council and Pastor’s United for Change. As of 2014, she’s been appearing as official host of Englewood’s Back to School Parade, the second oldest African American parade in Chicago.

Meechie is a national member of the Screen Actors Guild - American Federation of Television and Radio Artists (SAG-AFTRA) who currently does background and some acting for various TV shows including Empire, Chicago PD, Chicago Med (just to name a few), short films, commercials, independent projects and Meechie’s Used News.
