5. Essay can be handwritten but preferred method is typewritten.

NOTIFICATION PROCESS:

1. All individuals chosen will be notified by Monday, July 13th. An interview with the Englewood Back to School Parade Committee will be scheduled.
2. The interview will last 10 minutes. You must wear appropriate business attire (no jeans, cut-offs, etc.).
